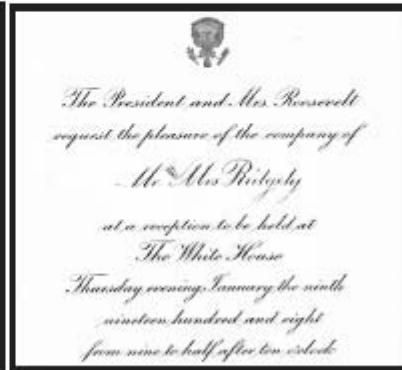

Garfield to the career of Henry White, a Ridgely cousin who served as Ambassador to Italy and France under Theodore Roosevelt.
