Impact Baltimore City & County Youth: Host an Intern this Summer!

History:

For the last 20+ years the Y in Central Maryland has been impacting the lives of youth experiencing homelessness in Baltimore City and County, in part through our New Horizons II program: a seven-week summer program offering life-skills development, academic enrichment, workforce experience and college access. The program provides a positive, supportive, safe and educational experience.

Operated virtually through partnerships with Baltimore County Schools, Baltimore County Department of Economic and Workforce Development, Baltimore City Public Schools, and Baltimore City's Mayor's Office of Employment Development, youth work up to 25 hours per week and earn \$11.75 per hour. These partnerships allow us to provide a summer of safety, support and critical life skills for these inspiring young people.

The worksite supervisor will:

- Assign a supervisor that will be assigned to supervisor and support participants each
- Provide an enriching work experience for students to report to work Monday-Friday between the hours of 11:30 am - 4:30 pm beginning July 6th - August 11th
- Identify skills that youth will learn from during the program. Upon completion, evaluate the participant's skills and abilities gained during the summer.
- Complete weekly timesheets.
- Attend a worksite orientation (dates TBD)

We look forward to partnering with you to provide an enriching employment experience for the youth that are enrolled in our New Horizons II program.
