Dear Towson Chamber Members and Friends, I want to share some important community updates.

Over the last year, we've had about 25 new businesses open up, most of them eateries. Did you know Towson has about 100 great restaurants within a one mile radius?

That's the good news, and the bad news. The good news is we have a lot of great places to choose from. The bad news is, about 45 % of the people that work in Towson are not here on any given day Monday thru Friday. So PLEASE, when you looking for a place to eat or something to buy, support one of our great community businesses.

I'm sure most of you have seen the BG&E trucks all around town. They are upgrading service lines and piping materials delivering natural gas to individual properties. If you have any questions, see the next page couple pages of the newsletter for more information.

We are so very grateful for all the support we have received from the state and local government in 2023. Our community will receive over \$510,000 for safety and streetscape improvements.

County Executive, Johnny Olszewski and the County Council approved a \$350,000 grant to the chamber to hire 6 security guards, 5 days a week. We also received additional funding for surveillance cameras in the alleys and for some of the surface parking lots.

We will also be receiving about \$160,000 from the State for security cameras, lighting, façade improvements, power washing sidewalks, streetscape improvements, murals, marketing and promotion for Towson and additional planters.

Towson also has a group of very committed people, like Calixta, Christina and our Board of Directors whose commitment to supporting Towson and making it the best place to live, go to school, work and play.

With all of these Stakeholders and our great Baltimore County Police, 2023 is going to be a great year for Towson!!

Every day I feel truly grateful to work with and for so many wonderful people.

I hope to see everyone at Gardens Day on May 4 and the Towsontown Spring Festival on May 6 & 7!

Towson Ph. 4 BGE Operation Pipeline Project

Dear BGE Customer,

BGE plans to upgrade the aging, underground natural gas mains in your neighborhood and throughout our service area to continue to deliver natural gas safely and reliably (see map of **Towson Phase 4** - Operation Pipeline Project on reverse). As part of this program, BGE will be upgrading the service lines and piping materials delivering natural gas to individual properties.

BGE authorized contractor **Northern Pipeline Contractors** (**NPL**) will be replacing the gas mains in the street and connecting customers' properties to the new gas system. This will require excavating the roads to access the gas mains, necessitating temporary lane closures and metal plates to cover the excavations in the off-hours. You may experience noise, dust, and debris. We will work to minimize the disturbance and we appreciate your patience.

During this process, our contractors will need unobstructed access to both the inside and outside of some properties to access the current gas equipment location, prepare for the service transfer, and install any necessary piping to connect your property to the upgraded equipment. You may not have gas service for several hours during the transfer process as contractors work to renew the service, test, and relight any gas-fed appliances. The pressure regulator device and an emergency shut-off valve will be installed on the exterior of your property requiring possible spot excavations in your yard and/or sidewalk. Once all gas equipment in your neighborhood is upgraded, BGE's paving contractor will repave disturbed road surfaces and replace temporary sidewalk patches with new concrete.

If appointments are necessary, you will be contacted directly, through a phone call or by a door hanger that will include the contractor's contact information.


