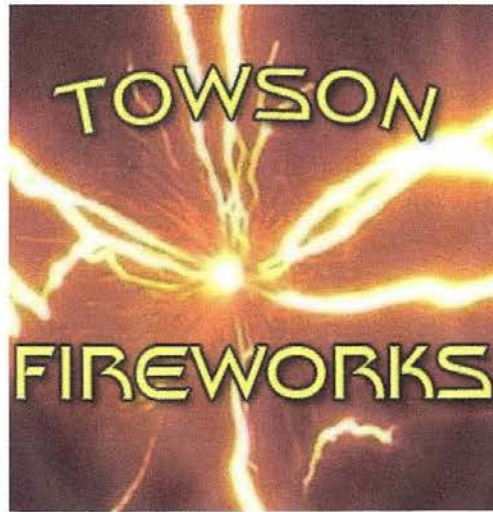

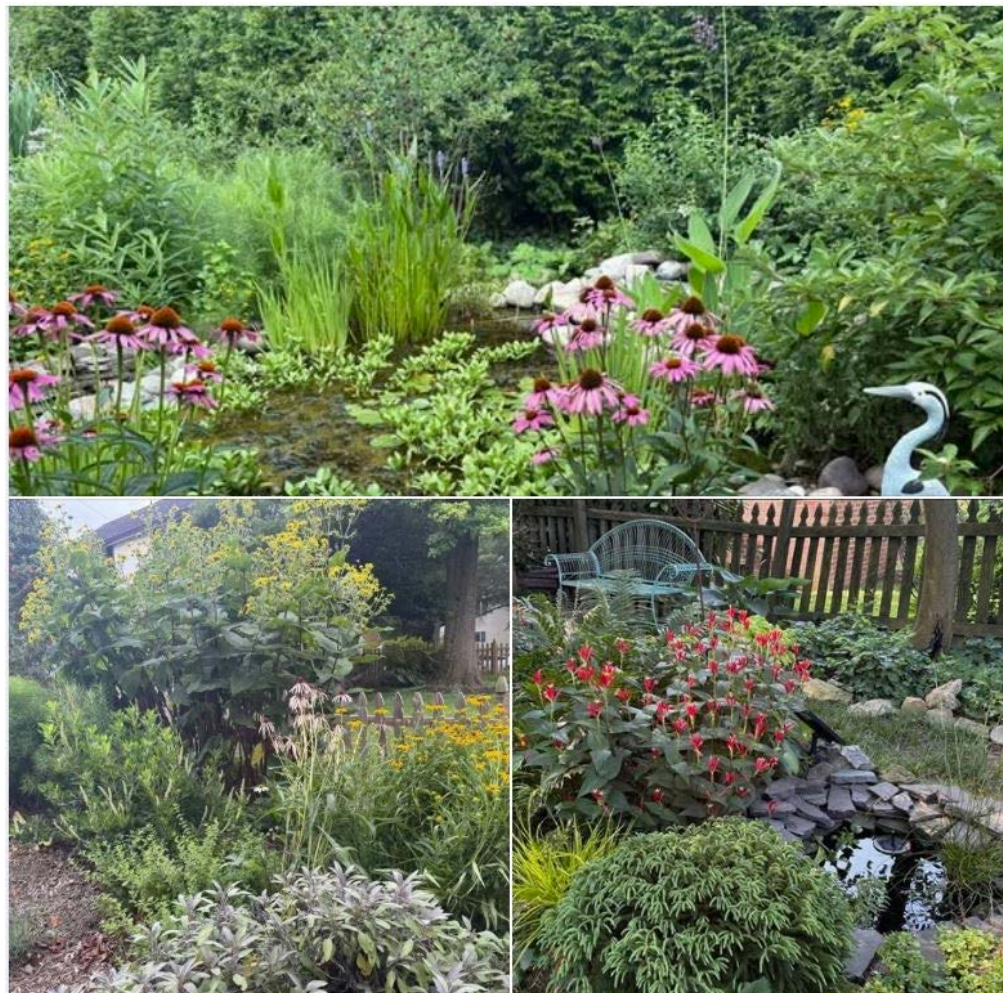

The Native Garden Contest will take place this summer, the sixth year it's been run by members of Green Towson Alliance. The purpose of the contest is to celebrate Towson gardeners who plant native plants in their yards. The University of Maryland Extension is emphasizing the use of native plants, shrubs and trees because they support pollinators - the butterflies, bees, and beneficial insects that pollinate the vegetables, fruits and grains that feed us. In addition, many native trees are the host plant for the butterflies that we enjoy seeing all summer. Monarch, swallowtails, and other butterflies lay their eggs only on specific plants because the caterpillars that hatch from their eggs can only digest those plants. We all know that Monarch butterflies lay their eggs on milkweed; in the same way, Zebra swallowtail butterflies only lay their eggs on our native Pawpaw trees, and the Baltimore Checkerspot butterfly can only lay its eggs on White Turtlehead. We hope to spread the word about the importance of native plants for our ecosystem through our contest.

We choose 3 winners of each contest in three categories, based on the size of the owner's yard. This year's contest will open for entries on Monday, June 8, and closes for new entries on July 7. You can see the winners from last year's contest, as well as the Finalists and Winners in the contests from 2021 through 2025. Towson neighbors can learn about the contest and how to enter on our contest website:

nativegardencontest.com In the past, we have highlighted some community gardens, and this year, any Towson business that grows and nurtures native plants and trees is welcome to enter the contest. The website will be updated regularly as the contest is underway this summer.
